Chinatown








MEETING ROOM FLOOR PLANS

TRANSPORTATION BY AIR

Direct flights to the Victoria International Airport arrive daily from Seattle, Vancouver, Calgary and Toronto. TRANSPORTATION BY SEA

Regularly scheduled ferry service connects Victoria to mainland British Columbia and Washington State. Each day, dozens of ferries cross the Juan de Fuca strait, providing breathtaking views of the rocky coastline, forested inlets and marine wildlife. Victoria's arrival points include the Inner Harbour, the Town of Sidney and the Swartz Bay ferry terminal (30 minutes from downtown Victoria). The following is a list of ferries that offer regularly scheduled service to Victoria:

British Columbia Ferries

Frequent daily scheduled service is provided (passengers and vehicles) between Tsawassen (south of Vancouver) and Swartz Bay (north of Victoria) or between Tsawassen and Duke Point (south of Nanaimo). Also, frequent service between Horseshoe Bay (West Vancouver) and Departure Bay (Nanaimo), to the Gulf Islands and other BC points.
